Mr Seah Moon Ming was appointed Managing Director of Singapore Technologies Electronics on 1 July 1997 and subsequently became its President on 8 December 1997.

He was appointed President, International Business and Deputy CEO of Singapore Technologies Engineering Ltd overseeing the Electronics and Land Systems sectors on 1 May 2004.

Mr. Seah started off as an engineer with Ministry of Defence in March 1981 and was with MINDEF for thirteen years, where he held a number of senior posts. In July 1994, Mr. Seah was appointed General Manager of CET Technologies. He was then appointed Managing Director of ST Electronics in July 1997.

Mr. Seah serves as Chairman of SES, Agilis, CET, STTS, DigiSAFE, Trusted Hub and Trusted Board. He is Vice Chairman of two public listed companies, viz, Trek 2000 Ltd and ECS Holdings Limited. He was recognised for his work with the union when he received the Medal of Commendation from the National Trade Union Congress, Singapore, in May 2001. A firm believer of continuing R&D, he is an inventor with a patent for "A Monitoring System" (December 2000).

Mr. Seah is Adjunct Professor to the National University of Singapore's Entrepreneurship Centre and Deputy Chairman of the Temasek Polytechnic Board of Governors as well as a Fellow of the Institution of Engineers Singapore (IES). He is also a Senior Member of IEEE and member of Eta Kappa Nu. In 2003, Mr Seah was appointed a member of the International Advisory Panel of the National ICT (Information and Communications Technology) Australia. He is also an Executive Council Member of the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade (PRC) and a member of the Network India Steering Committee of International Enterprise Singapore.

Mr Seah majored in electronics engineering at the National University of Singapore. He has a Master of Science (EE) with distinction at the Naval Postgraduate School, USA. He also attended the Stanford-NUS Executive Program and Program for Management Development at Harvard University USA.

Mr Seah is married and has three children; he enjoys swimming, chess and golf.
