

## **PORT LIMIT SPECIAL GRADE (DECK OFFICER) COURSE**

### **AIM**

To familiarise harbour craft masters with the Port waters, Aids to Navigation and an understanding of Port Regulations so as to provide them with the knowledge required for safe navigation within port limits.

### **FOR WHOM**

Holders of Certificate of Competency (Deck) applying for Port Limit Special Grade (Deck Officer) Manning Licence.

### **COVERAGE OF COURSE**

The course covers the following topics:

- Commonly used Marine Vocabulary
- Signals and Communication
- Port Regulations
- Restricted and Prohibited Areas
- Anchorages and their Purposes
- Outlying Islands and their Activities
- Steering and Sailing Rules
- Main Navigational Aids
- Oil Record Book
- Local Tides and Tidal Streams
- Relevant Port Marine Circulars and Notices to Mariners
- Emergency Procedures

### **PRE-REQUISITE REQUIREMENTS**

- a) Seafarers with valid Certificate of Competency (Deck) recognised by MPA.
- b) Must have a working knowledge of English

**CERTIFICATION:** Participant who attained 100% attendance and passed both written and oral examination will be awarded Port Limit Special Grade (Deck Officer) Course Certificate by Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore.

**DURATION:** 3 Days

**COURSE FEE:** S\$463.05 (subjected to prevailing GST)
