RISK MANAGEMENT & INCIDENT INVESTIGATION (RMII)

AIM

The aim of the RMII course is to equip participants with the ability to explain the difference between a prescriptive approach and a risk-based approach to risk management and describe a structured approach to risk assessment and incident investigation.

OBJECTIVE OF COURSE

At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Understand the general philosophy and methodology of risk assessment
- Identify hazards, assess, evaluate and control risk of work processes at the workplace.
- Carry out structured risk assessments
- Conduct structured incident investigations

- What is risk management and risk assessment
- Formal Safety Assessment (FSA)
- Implementing a risk assessment programme
- Cost benefits of risk assessment
- Principles of effective investigation
- Purpose of the investigation
- What should be investigated
